National will be sending a notice in Guide Post to alert units when the date for payment of Fall 2020 cookies has been decided.

CLASSIC COOKIES 2021

For BC, a partnership has been negotiated to sell a large quantity of classic cookies through a retail partner in BC stores this spring. This will be the only type of classic cookie sale in BC during the spring months and all proceeds will be shared with BC

units, districts, and areas. All units will sell classic cookies in the fall. Additional details have been sent by email to BC members.

ADULT MEMBERSHIP FEES

Since BC Council pays the annual \$60 membership fees to National for all registered BC Guiders, they have been looking at the ratios between girls and registered adult members. BC Council is paying 1 adult member for every 2.54 registered girls (10,123 girls).

Moving forward, the expectation will be that all members whose membership fees are being paid for by BC Council will make an effort to be involved, to help out and to stay connected to activities being done by the girls.
